


In 1937, the years of autarky in Italy, Turin-based Urmet reconverted the existing telephony park to make it reusable.

The stages of our history

On April, 28th Cinecittà was inaugurated in Rome and on December 21st, Walt Disney presented the first full-length animated film in history at the cinema.

Urmet was founded in Turin as an Italian Limited Company for the Utilisation and Recovery of Electro-Telephone Equipment.

These were the years of autarchy, when Italy had to cope with the economic sanctions following the Ethiopian war. The reconversion, reuse and exploitation of the technology developed up to that point became crucial.







The first Urmet-branded product comes

onto the market: namely the BCA (central battery) telephone. Representing a turning point for the company, it is the first product designed and sold under the brand name in Italy and Argentina.

BCA telephones were introduced in rural communities after 1945, thanks in part to the technological heritage accumulated through the company's previous remanufacturing activities.

Urmet started mass production of door phones and the first Urmet-branded entry panel was born.

These were the years in which intercom was born, hitherto unknown and little perceived as something needed by society. The method introduced by Urmet to manage the numerous wires that used to arrive on the front of the external entry panel was revolutionary.



The wires of the system reach up to a counterbutton inserted on the internal frame case of the entry panel, so that the latter can be disassembled and controlled more easily. Electricians liked the system so much that it became the standard and was adopted by other manufacturers.

The first Italian video intercom was designed in 1965.



First public telephone for local and long-distance calls. In 1982, pre-paid magnetic phone cards were patented Expansion of the group abroad began, with the French company Captiv and the Brazilian firm Daruma. The company's reach was further extended.

With Urmet Domus, **the business focused on building systems and automation**, consolidating the video door phone catalogue. By this point, the video door phone had become synonymous with Urmet, and this effective and user-friendly tool was increasingly present in Italian homes as a symbol of security and convenience.

On June, 29th, the first iPhone went on sale in the US. On October,15th, the Airbus A380, the world's largest passenger aircraft capable of carrying 853 people, entered into service.


Urmet celebrates 85 years in business.


